

6th GRADE ART EXPLORATORY CLASS

All 6th graders at VOL will have art as one of their exploratory classes. This class meets once a week for 2 nine-week periods. Some of the concepts included in this class are contour sketching, cartooning, origami, holiday art, personality portraits, and several other types of imaginative and creative artwork. Students are required to bring a sharpened pencil with eraser, markers, and crayons or colored pencils to every art class.

All students will receive a grade of above average, average or below average on their report cards based on their effort, behavior, and the quality of the work they turn in. All drawings will be kept in a folder in the classroom and will be returned at the end of each nine weeks. Students will be expected to put forth their best effort in all of the work that they submit.

Discipline is taken seriously in exploratory classes. Students should always report to class in a timely manner. Proper classroom behavior is also expected. Tardiness, disrespect, disruptive behavior, or any other behavior that does not coincide with the student handbook or code of conduct for middle school students will result in a consequence. Since this class meets only once a week, students will not receive repeated warnings before earning a demerit. Students who fail to bring supplies to class will be issued only one supply/procedure notice before receiving a demerit.
